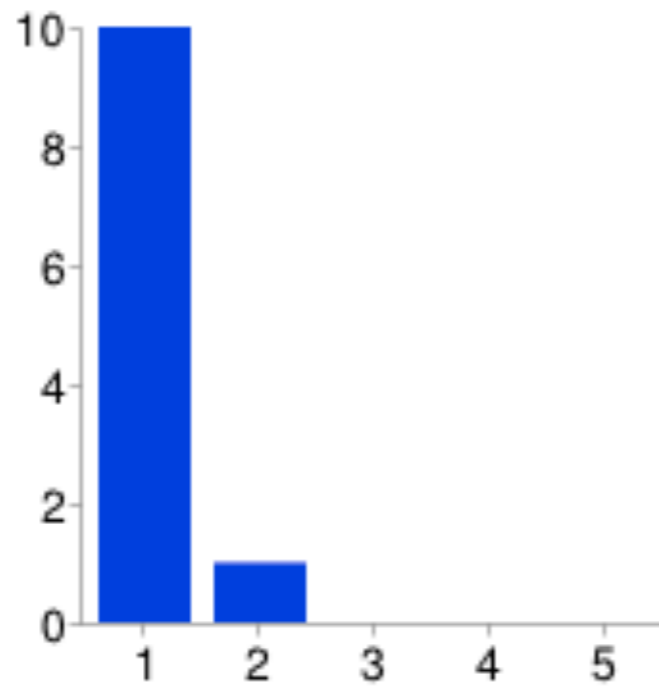

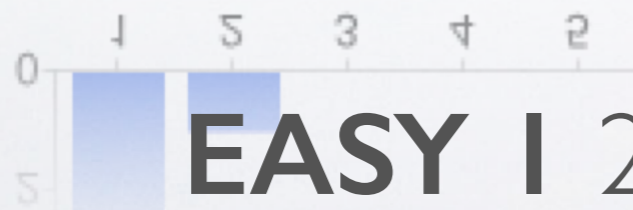

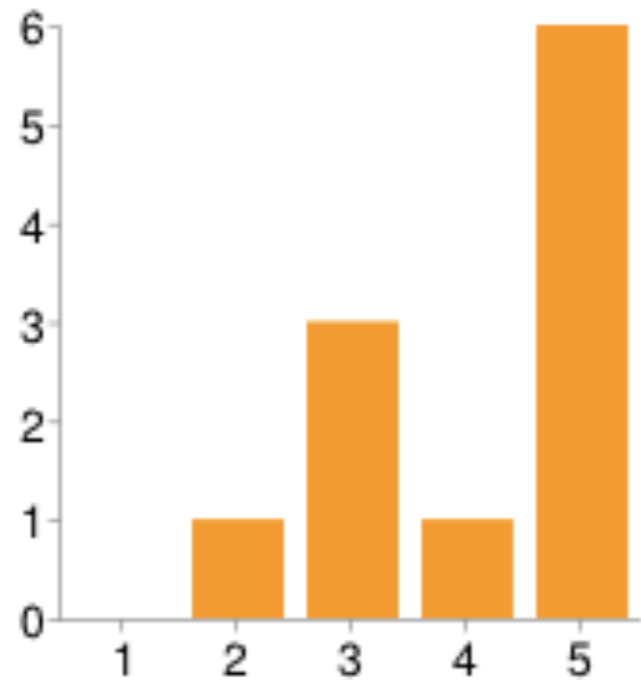

I found the time allotted to complete a syllabus-

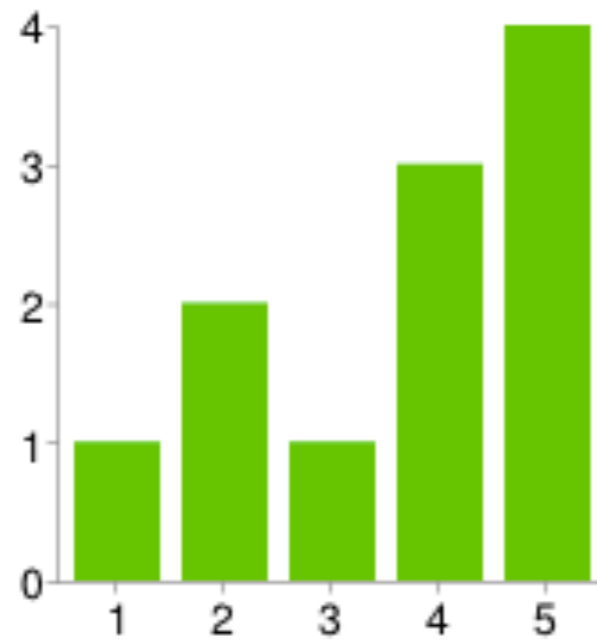

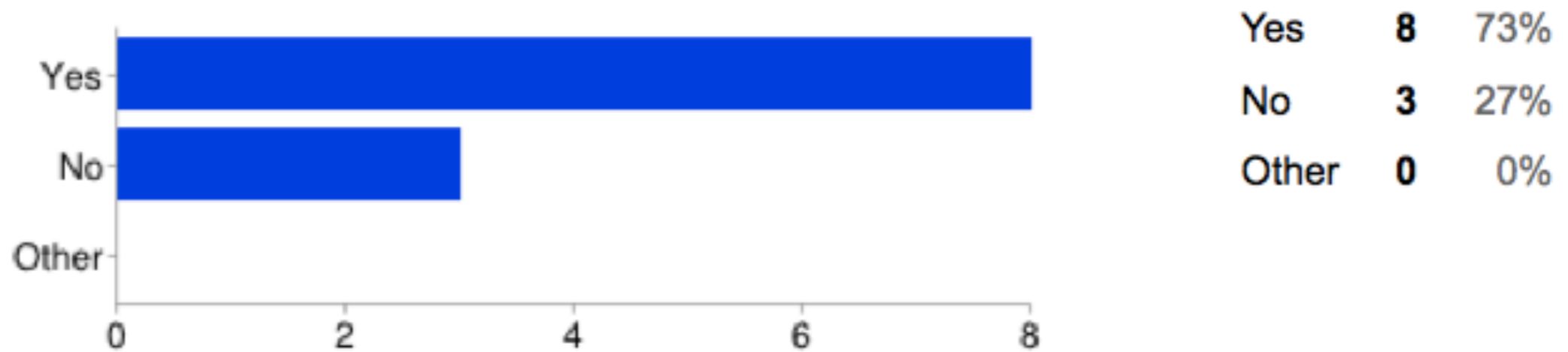
